The review and assessment of bursary, award and scholarship applications are separate and distinct processes carried out by the office of Student Financial Services and will not influence your admission decision.

- 1) Indicate your name and OMSAS number along with the name of the award that you are applying for.
- 2) Include a statement of a maximum of 200 words outlining your suitability for the award.
- 3) Submit a copy of your current CV (maximum of four pages).

LASZLO MIKLOS KINDLER SCHOLARSHIP

\$3,000

The scholarship will be awarded to an incoming medical student on the basis of academic excellence. Preference will be given to a student with a demonstrated interest in the study of philosophy.

DR. ROBERT L. SMITH AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN ADVANCING HEALTHY CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT

2 awards at \$1,000 each

To be awarded to a student entering the undergraduate medical program who demonstrates excellence and commitment in creating and/or participating in activities to advance healthy childhood and adolescent development. The activities may be school, employment or volunteer-based. An activity must be at minimum six months in duration but the six months need not be contiguous months. Activities may be local, regional, national or global but the nature of the activity is important and evaluated not its location.
